The front is adorned with a large drawer, complete with its original bronze locks and handles. The interior of the drawer is made of fir with the original period bottom. The writing desk has been conservatively restored, preserving the patina and the wood's original characteristics. It is in excellent condition and ready to be placed in any setting.
