Elegant vintage serpent ring in 18K yellow gold, richly decorated with vivid emerald-green enamel and set with two small round diamonds for the eyes. The ring is designed as a sinuous snake curling around the finger, with a sculptural openwork body and finely textured enamel scales that give the piece a strong Art Nouveau Revival character. The serpent has been one of the most iconic motifs in fine jewellery since the 19th century, symbolising eternity, transformation, protection and seduction. This example beautifully revives that historic language in a mid-century luxury style, combining warm yellow gold, bright green enamel and discreet diamond accents.
