Description

This miniature palanquin is stamped with a "YOKSANG B" mark and Vietnamese characters. It was likely a salt shaker. It was a Chinese-origin silversmith's workshop established in French Indochina, active between the late 19th century and the 1930s-1950s. The object may have been "manufactured in China or Indochina." This is not a hallmark; in China, unlike in France, there was no system comparable to the Minerve. The marks were primarily commercial.
