### Description

Bronze sculpture depicting a hunting dog, signed by Dubucand (1828-1903) Alfred Dubucand (born Bucand), a student of Antoine-Louis Barye, won an award at the 1867 Salon. As an animal sculptor, he most often modeled groups of animals--deer, dogs, and horses--but also excelled in Orientalist sculpture. Renowned for his attention to detail, his ability to capture movement in mid-action, and the finesse and elegance of his chiseling, he was on par with the animal sculptors of his time.
