Description

This historical portrait, masterfully executed in oil on a convex wooden panel during the second half of the 19th century, represents a magnificent example of the European academic school. The artwork is a highly artistic interpretation by an unidentified European master, L. (or C.) Jacob, based on the famous monumental masterpiece by Sir Francis Grant (1855) depicting the legendary British commander, Field Marshal George Charles Bingham, 3rd Earl of Lucan (1800-1888). The Earl is dressed in a formal general's uniform, and upon his chest shines the highest honor of Great Britain: the Star of the Knight Grand Cross of the Order of the Bath, awarded to him immediately upon his return from the Crimea. All elements of his accoutrements, including the hilt of his sabre and the bicorne hat with its lush

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plumage, are painted with exceptional attention to detail. A landscape serves as the background, where a devoted orderly holds an impatient warhorse by the bridle. The artist Jacob brilliantly adapted Grant's large-scale canvas to the miniature format of a spherical plaque, giving the figure a tangible three-dimensional volume and quite literally bringing the field marshal's image to life. This unique piece will become a highly prized discovery for serious collectors of military-historical art dedicated to the heroes and battles of bygone eras.
