Shin guards tsutsu Suneate sign. Soshu ju Sadayuki saku ??????In the sabiji design, with a lovely patina with red-orange lacing. The connection of the three segments of the shin guard is implemented by profiled hinges, the knee protection, the tateage is very nicely formed by longitudinal flutes. The lining of the shins is made with gold brocade. Master Sadayuki ?? from the famous Myochin ?? family lived and worked in the mid-16th century in Odawara in Sagami province (Soshu). According to the genealogy of the Masuda branch of the Myochin lineage, mentioned in "Kokon kaji mei hayamidashi ????????", Sadayuki was a student of the 18th generation master, Myochin Sadaie ?? ?. The genealogy of the Myochin family, Katchu zukan, states: „Student of Sadaie,
