An extremely fine and tight weave, featuring the large Tree of Life motif in the central field. Multiple borders with geometric patterns separated by lines like piano keys. A design that reads from bottom to top. A subtle, delicate harmony of plant-based hues. Here it is! This one has unusual dimensions. Usually, the length does not exceed 200 cm. Pastel tones.
