Description

André AVELINE (1930-2002) Landscape of the Vosges with a Solitary Tree Oil on hardboard Signed lower right 40 x 53 cm | 48 x 57 cm with frame - Early work by André Aveline, who trained under Auguste Boehringer (1913-1974). This plein air painting, in the post-Impressionist style, centers on a solitary, dynamic, almost sculptural tree dominating a valley with bluish hills. The free and supple brushwork, the handling of the paint in the impasto of the sky (which reveals Aveline's interest in an increasingly expressive pictorial style); the autumnal palette with its harmonies of ochres and purples, as well as the softness of the light, reveal a sincere painting, deeply attached to the expressive beauty of the Vosges landscapes, which would remain at the heart of his entire
