The door panels are embellished with a refined floral motif inspired by the Louis XV style, illustrating the stylistic evolution of the 18th century. The antique and meticulous construction is distinguished by flat drawer bottoms, a back made of wide planks, traditional joinery, and a wrought-iron lock with its original key, which is in perfect working order. The piece features a harmonious patina and signs of wear consistent with its age, attesting to its
