Description

Monogram M.P. (19th-20th centuries) Symbolist portrait of a man Signed pastel, dated 1912 53 x 44 cm (image size) | 61 x 52 cm (with frame)-Large pastel on paper dated 1912, signed with a monogram "M.P." that remains unidentified. This figure, with the air of a man of letters or an artist, his gaze raised and his expression inspired, almost visionary, exudes a singular presence. The ethereal application of the pastel, the muted shades of brown, gray, and black, and the elegance of the silhouette place the work within a Symbolist aesthetic and evoke the atmosphere of the artistic, literary, and bohemian circles of Montparnasse in the 1910s. More than a simple portrait, it presents an idealized figure, in which the psychological intensity and aura of the model take precedence over the pursuit of realism.
