Japanese bronze yatate from the Edo period (1603-1868), crafted in the shape of a pipe. It features an ink reservoir and a shaft designed to hold a brush. Naturalistic decoration featuring finely carved leaves and a stem, demonstrating meticulous craftsmanship. Yatate were carried by scholars, merchants, and travelers, providing them with the ink needed for correspondence and writing; some Yatate were sometimes used to conceal small weapons for self-defense.
