Description

Michel TURAS (1894-1979) River in the Jura Oil on canvas, signed lower right Handwritten date on the back of the frame 22 x 27 cm | 31 x 36 cm with frame - Dated August 1957, this oil on canvas is representative of Michel Turas's (1894-1979) landscape work. Trained at the School of Fine Arts in Kaunas (Lithuania) before continuing his artistic career in Paris, where he frequented the artistic circles of Montmartre and the Grande Chaumière, the artist later settled in Abbans-Dessus, in Franche-Comté. He created the murals in the birthplace of Saint Joseph Marchand in Passavant and found a constant source of inspiration in the Loue and Doubs valleys. This landscape of rushing waters among limestone rocks, likely painted en plein air, belongs to the period when he exhibited in

It reveals a highly personal style: a generous texture built up with a fragmented, grainy brushstroke, a refined palette of greens, blues, and purples, and a vibrant light, drawing on the Post-Impressionist tradition, all in the service of a highly sensitive interpretation of the subject.
