RenéXavier François Prinnet (1861-1946):  
"Woman at the Balustrade," charcoal 30 × 23 cm,  
mounted with a beveled mat in a modern black  
frame 47 × 40 cm. A photocopy of the Bénézit  
entry glued to the back identifies the work, which  
may be linked to a painting sold last year in the  
United States. A faint trace of writing is barely  
visible in the lower right corner, which could be a  
monogram. This artist, who follows in the  
tradition of the Impressionists, is not well known  
despite a vigorous and sensitive style ranging  
from Art Nouveau to Art Deco; like our  
drawing--whose passion, combined with an  
economy of means, suggests a young woman
