Description

This English gateleg table made of solid oak dates from the late 17th or early 18th century, corresponding to the William III / early Queen Anne period. It rests on a base with six turned legs joined by crossbars and features a gateleg mechanism to support the two folding wings. The tabletop, made of wide oak planks, displays a beautiful antique patina and an authentic appearance, with normal signs of wear consistent with its age. Both practical and elegant, this table could serve as a dining table or a side table. When folded, it takes up very little space, while its leaves provide a generous surface when extended. A fine example of antique English furniture, prized for the quality of its craftsmanship, its balanced proportions, and the charm of its weathered oak.
