This folding model, more elaborate than fixed toasters, folds completely flat for easy storage. The crossbar is engraved with the monogram "EM", likely a period owner's mark. A beautiful handcrafted piece of wrought iron, representative of household utensils from the 18th and early 19th centuries. Antique patina and signs of wear consistent with its age.
