Description

Paul SINNIGER (1892-1971) Still Life with Tulips Oil on hardboard Signed, dated 1946 42 x 30 cm | 50.5 x 38.5 cm with frame - Dated 1946, this still life is a work by the Alsatian painter Paul Sinniger (1892-1971), who was born and died in Sierentz. A railroad worker, painter and decorator at the Mulhouse-Riedisheim workshop, conductor of the Musique Concordia de Sierentz, and a local figure active in the Alsatian Resistance, he developed a sincere figurative style, attentive to the play of light and the harmony of colors. This bouquet captures the natural beauty of a freshly picked arrangement, where buds, emerging blossoms, and fully bloomed flowers coexist. The simplicity and transparency of the vase contribute to the luminous freshness of the composition, in which--one year after the end of the war--the
