A very pretty clock for a young girl's bedroom, featuring a pair of birds in a nest with three eggs. The details of the nest and the birds' plumage are rendered with great finesse. Made of onyx and gilded marble, it has a beautiful patina and is sold with its pendulum and key. Once repaired, it will once again be able to chime the hours. An interesting detail: a motif of two pecking roosters appears in a cartouche on the base of this clock; this was a revolutionary design adopted in 1790, and it is highly likely that this clock was crafted in keeping with the tastes of the time. The Roman numeral 1 is missing. Careful shipping worldwide
