Signature: The base of the box bears the elephant stamp, the historic emblem and authentic signature of the Zohiko workshop, guaranteeing the piece's Kyoto origin and high-quality craftsmanship. objects of this nature, the following signs of age should be noted: Structural defect: A chip is visible on one of the corners of the box. Signs of use: Glue residue is present on the back of the object, but does not affect the appearance of the decorated side.
