Description

Pair of lacquered beech Queen's armchairs stamped "JB Boulard," from the Louis XVI period. Tuileries brand mark, remnants of a delivery label. Order No. 617 of October 18, 1784 "for the Queen at the Tuileries, Cabinet of the Nobles (...) 4 square Queen's armchairs with sloping armrests, fluted turned legs, and double molding around the perimeter (...) Chatard, commissioned under the same order number, executed "white varnished paint." Condition report: restored by our workshop in January-April 2026. Reupholstered with 19th-century Lyon silk in the Louis XVI style.
