The trophy is mounted on an oval shield imitating intertwined branches, embellished with raised ivy leaves, in the style of late 19th-century hunting-themed decor. The back retains its original mounting system, allowing for easy wall hanging. An original decorative piece, combining wood carving and natural elements, highly representative of the Belle Époque's taste for decorative trophies.
