Bearing the Corps' ink seal, this certifies a wound caused by a cannonball to Second Lieutenant L'Hauterelle, A WOUND HE DID NOT HAVE BEFORE THE BATTLE OF ESLING. SIGNED BY GENERAL MICHEL , WHO DIED IN ACTION ON JUNE 18, 1815 AT THE AGE OF 42 AT THE BATTLE OF WATERLOO .THE MEDALS PREVIOUSLY OFFERED FOR SALE WERE ACCOMPANIED BY THIS DOCUMENT
