Teapot height: 13 cm. Cup height: 6.5 cm. Claudio La Viola was born in Milan, where he lives and works. Self-taught from a very young age, he expressed his creativity in the world of fashion, where he established himself as a designer in the 1970s. These same

His approach is purist, passionate, and enthusiastic, always seeking to convey emotion through his work, as he asserts that "a design without a soul is a design without distinction" Claudio La Viola has worked for companies such as Agape, Falper, Rapsel, Richard Ginori, Viabizzuno, Zani&Zani, and Brix Richard-Ginori, renamed Ginori 1735 as of 2020, is a company founded on October 11, 1896 as a result of the merger of the Richard Céramique company, originally from Lombardy, with the Manifattura di Doccia owned by Marquis Carlo Ginori, founded in 1737 in the town of Doccia Richard-Ginori, which was officially declared bankrupt in January 2013, was acquired in May 2013 by the Gucci Group.
