Relay*****PICHET: a pewter baluster pitcher with a short, slanted base, a "postilion's boot"-shaped cup, and a recessed lid with an S-shaped thumbhole and a molded ridge. Model by one of the VOVELLE family. Height: 15 cm. CHARTRES, Second half of the 19th century. In perfect condition. These so-called "ration" pitchers were used in religious hospitable communities in the Chartres region and surrounding areas. Jean-Baptiste and Francis VOVELLE were active from the mid- to late 19th century and, for half a century, produced these so-called "ration" pitchers for religious and hospital communities.
