Below, a pair of curved umbrella rests are raised on turned supports above a serpentine plinth base, complete with the original painted zinc liner (drip tray) and terminating in bun feet. Retaining its excellent original color and rich mahogany wood, the stand is fitted with a total of ten turned coat or hat hooks across the four branches and central upright. English, circa 1870.
