Jean Derval joined them in 1947. They thus contributed to the "Renaissance" of ceramics in Vallauris. In 1952, Capron purchased the Font des Horts pottery in Vallauris and, with seven workers, produced objects for gift shops and decorative panels there. In 1955, he married Jacqueline Hubin, known as "Jacotte,"
