From its inception, the Lorraine Cross was always included in the signature until 1945; since then, the signature has been simply "Daum France" in a very simple and refined style. This vase was also made for the Marquise de Sévigné; this particular piece does not bear that inscription. TBE Height: 14 cm Diameter: 15.5 cm
