The work captures the traditional flower market amidst passersby, with the architectural details of the Guild Houses and City Hall in the background. Belgian School, Impressionist, Post-Impressionist, and Luminist styles. A beautiful, textured, and thick painterly touch, particularly evident in the colorful rendering of the bouquets of flowers in the foreground. Early 20th century, circa 1920-1930, as evidenced by the characters' attire and the distinctive silhouette of the Belgian civic guard/gendarme in a dark uniform and light-colored helmet on the right.
