Description

An elegant table planter in silver-plated bronze, signed by Victor Saglier, featuring a remarkable rocaille design inspired by the Louis XV style. Its dynamic form is accentuated by powerful asymmetrical scrolls, shells, and finely chiseled foliage. The openwork side handles blend harmoniously into the composition and rest on four arched legs, lending the piece great elegance. The quality of the cast bronze and the chiseling attests to the craftsmanship of the Victor Saglier workshop, one of the most important Parisian goldsmiths of the late 19th century. The planter retains its original inner tray, designed to hold floral arrangements--a feature often missing from pieces of this type. Dimensions: Length: 41 cm Width: 22 cm Height: 12 cm
