The plant-inspired motif reveals a great freedom of movement typical of the era. The "gendarme's hat"-style front panel presents a silhouette that combines curves and slender lines. The central drawer also leans toward naturalism. The curved uprights are reminiscent of branches. The design is confident; even the sides exude flexibility, harmony, and balance. The hooks and handle are made of bronze, and the original zinc trays are lacquered in aqua green. The handles of the umbrella stand are made of brass. The speckled maple panels contrast beautifully with the oak frame. The beveled, scalloped, and curved glass completes the picture. A rare model.
