Description

A portrait of a woman by the Neapolitan painter Vincenzo Montefusco, signed in the lower left corner and dated 1891. The work depicts a cultured young woman in a three-quarter view, with her face turned toward the viewer and her head wrapped in a vibrant red scarf. The composition highlights the artist's finest qualities: the delicate rendering of the skin tone, the smoothness of the color transitions, and the psychological sensitivity that animates the figure's gaze. Montefusco was a student of Domenico Morelli at the Academy of Fine Arts in Naples and established himself as one of the most highly regarded practitioners of genre painting in southern Italy during the second half of the nineteenth century.
