Tableware from the Tamnay-en-Bazois pottery (Nièvre), founded in 1932 by Gaston Gaubier (1894-1971). The "Flammés du Morvan," featuring a unique glazing technique, were known as "Les Grès du Morvan." The richness of the colors is reminiscent of Monet's pointillism. This set includes - 12 dinner plates, 25.5 x 22.5 cm- 12 soup bowls, diameter: 18.5 cm- 1 "round" serving dish 27 x 25 cm- 1 oval platter 36.5 x 26 cm- 1 ramekin 22.5 x 14 cm- 1 ramekin and 1 soup tureen included free of charge due to one or two tiny chips Shipping via Cocolis within France; quote available upon request.
