Meyer" Approximate date: late 19th century Dimensions: 55 x 38 cm (image area) / 66 x 49 cm with frame Period wooden frame with gilded stucco decoration featuring scrollwork and foliage motifs? Forest glade scene: a path running through the composition, with the solitary silhouette of a walker in the center. 19th-century school, in the tradition of the Barbizon School landscape painters and their followers. Slightly illegible signature, tentatively attributed to Émile Meyer (1823-1893), a landscape and animal painter whose work remains poorly documented. The canvas and frame have undergone some routine restoration.?
