Accolay matte-glazed stoneware vase, from a pottery studio active from 1945 to 1983 in the Yonne department, "Gauloise series," baluster-shaped, decorated with raised lines alternating between turquoise blue and black. Series known as "Gauloise" Named after the color of the cigarette packs of the same name 1960s Very good condition, black glaze on the interior. Height: 34 cm Diameter: 21 cm /at the neck: 10 cm "Accolay" signature incised beneath the base In the mid-20th century, Accolay was the setting for a true revolution in ceramics. Four former students of Alexandre Kostanda settled in the small village in the Yonne region in the mid-1940s; many potters would follow their example. For some forty years, the work of Accolay's potters was impressive, original, and

For more than 20 years, a style of pottery flourished in Accolay that combined a diversity of objects--masks, jewelry, toys, and more--with a variety of materials--ceramics, glass, plant fibers... all while blending aesthetic appeal with "Zazou" humor.
