Description

French painter and printmaker of the Barbizon School. A student of Camille Flers, Louis-Nicolas Cabat made his debut at the 1833 Salon. A member of the Accademia di San Luca in Rome, he was elected to the Academy of Fine Arts of the Institut de France in 1867 and served as director of the Académie de France in Rome from 1879 to 1884. Executed on gray laid paper. Studio stamp in the lower right corner. Inscribed and dated in the lower right corner: "Chalais, May 24, 1845". Two rust spots in the middle toward the bottom.
