Small writing desk or lady's writing desk in mottled mahogany and gilded bronze. It opens with a drop-down panel revealing four drawers and four leather-lined compartments, and features two doors in the lower section. It rests on four curved legs. Gilded bronze ornamentation on the moldings, lock plates, and feet. The top is made of molded Aleppo marble. H.: 129 cm; W.: 72.5 cm; D.: 38 cm. 18th-century Parisian piece, transitional period between the Louis XV and Louis XVI eras. Re-varnished, in good condition, period bronze fittings re-gilded, 19th-century lock on the drop-down panel; one panel is slightly loose on one side.
