Description

A religious painting depicting the Coronation of the Virgin. The Virgin Mary, kneeling on a cloud and surrounded by cherubs, receives the heavenly crown from the Risen Christ and God the Father, while the dove of the Holy Spirit--a symbol of the Holy Trinity--appears at the center of the composition. The work stands out for its harmonious composition and the delicate rendering of the faces, particularly those of the Virgin and the cherubs, which are characterized by remarkable expressive tenderness. The soft drapery in shades of blue, pink, and ivory is set against an evocative celestial backdrop, typical of late Baroque devotional painting. In terms of style, iconography, and technique, the painting can be attributed to 18th-century Sicilian art, likely intended for a private oratory, a chapel, or

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an ecclesiastical setting. The canvas was historically re-stretched for conservation purposes and is now mounted on a later stretcher. Its overall state of preservation is good and consistent with the work's period, showing normal signs of aging.
