Description

A beautiful pair of vases produced by the Ginori manufactory in the late 19th century. Signed at the base and in excellent condition, with no visible restorations or breaks. Baluster-shaped vases featuring a bell-shaped base and a flared, funnel-like rim. The decoration is executed in the so-called "grotesque" style, inspired by Italian Renaissance majolica (specifically 16th-century Urbino models). The design is set against a glossy, milky-white background. At the center of the globular body, an architectural cartouche--framed in ochre yellow and black--depicts a lakeside or coastal landscape with mountains in the background. They measure 37 cm in height and 19 cm at their widest point.
