Description

A figurative Art Nouveau vase depicting a young woman sitting under a tree, with a lute resting on her lap. 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back to 1853 in Duchcov (German: Dux). Around 1898, the factory, led by Eduard Eichler, began producing artistic porcelain, distinguished by its soft, flowing forms and a style typical of Art Nouveau. Pieces from this period often depict allegorical figures of women and young men, presented in a poetic and introspective atmosphere.
