### Description

Oval tray decorated with a mythological scene depicting the adventures of the mischievous Cupid. The half-naked nymph and the little god floating in the air are both depicted in a forest setting. Signature: Aug. Moreau France, 19th/20th centuries. Pewter. Length: 45 cm, width: 29 cm. Condition: good. August Moreau (1834-1917)--a French sculptor from a family of artists. His father and his older brothers, Hippolyte and Mathurin, were all dedicated to crafting metal figures. In 1861, he made his debut at the Salon, where he regularly exhibited his works until 1913. He specialized in pastoral and allegorical representations.
