Plaster bust of Vitellius (Aulus Vitellius), Roman emperor in A.D. 69, during the tumultuous "Year of the Four Emperors." Vitellius was known for his corpulence and his love of life's pleasures, which is well reflected in the plump cheeks and double chin of this bust. His reign lasted only a few months before he was defeated by Vespasian and met a violent end. This sculpture dates from the late 20th century, between 1980 and 1990. Dimensions: 60H x 40L x 23P
