Richly adorned with finely chiseled gilded bronze: scrollwork featuring mascarons, claw feet, an openwork gallery, and highly elegant rocaille motifs. The interior, divided into compartments, houses an antique penholder with a metal nib, adding to the charm and authenticity of the piece.
