A superb set of Sarreguemines earthenware from the late 19th century, with a period stamp on the back by Paul Utzschneider. Featuring a polychrome design typical of Strasbourg, with a red-combed rim and, in the center of the plate, different bouquets of flowers on each piece. Decor embellished with small insects such as butterflies, dragonflies, and bees... Pure white background. Glossy glaze. Iridescent colors. Slightly scalloped Louis XV shape. Very good overall condition. Set consists of: 12 dinner plates: 24 cm; 11 soup plates; 12 dessert plates; 2 serving platters: 1 round, 1 rectangular; 2 footed bowls: 1 tall - 1 short; 2 small bowls; 1 large soup tureen with a handle shaped like a ripe pomegranate for a total of 42 pieces.
