Description

Set of 6 Limoges porcelain breakfast cups, Haviland Manufactory, Louveciennes pattern. First released in 1974, the Louveciennes collection is inspired by a neoclassical design created in the 18th century by the Sèvres porcelain manufactory for Marie Antoinette. The design consists of alternating blue and gold medallions adorned with a rose and gold medallions. Between the medallions, garlands of intertwined laurel leaves frame motifs featuring roses and barbel fish. The background of the plates is adorned with a bouquet of flowers surrounded by golden foliage and garlands of intertwined laurel leaves.
