Description

A rare and compact collector's cabinet serving as a marble and lithograph collection. The cabinet, made of veneer and blackened wood, opens to reveal a compartment hidden within the curved top. It also opens via a flap that reveals 4 drawers containing 50 samples, some of which have retained their original labels. It includes a document holder containing the complete catalog detailing the stones. Inscription on the catalog: "Property of C.W. Packe, dated 1841". In good overall condition. Key and lock are functional. Early 19th-century Roman craftsmanship. Our tabletop cabinet is a beautiful and rare memento of the Grand Tour. Height 26 cm. Length 25.5 cm. Width 17.5 cm. Library. A more elaborately decorated example, it seems, was estimated at 800e and sold for 36,000 e by Oxio.
