Kurdish dagger known as a Khanjar--Iraq or Syria, 19th century Tapered wooden hilt overlaid with silver. Sheath made entirely of silver, partially gilded on the display side. Curved, double-edged blade with a central ridge. Blade forged from Damascus (wootz) steel. The blade steel is pitted in places. I believe the blade was reattached at some point. Length: 50 cm Length without sheath: 45 cm Blade length: 25.5 cm Weight: 690 g Weight without sheath: 410 g
