Description

Glazed earthenware vase with a globular body, baluster neck, and a pedestal with beveled sides. It is entirely hand-painted with a rich polychrome floral design in shades of blue, green, yellow, and brown, accented with ochre outlines, reminiscent of French pieces inspired by Quimper earthenware. Decorative styles of this type were widely produced by various French manufacturers in the early 20th century. This piece captivates with its striking decorative presence, the harmony of its colors, and the finesse of its hand-painted design. It will fit perfectly into a classic interior or a collection of antique earthenware. Please note: there is an old crack at the base, visible on the underside; it has not been restored but does not detract from the overall decorative quality of the piece. Shipping
