A superb Boulle marquetry box dating from the second half of the 19th century, from the Napoleonic era. This remarkable box is distinguished by its first-class Boulle marquetry on a pewter background, a variation that is much rarer than the traditional dyed tortoiseshell backgrounds. The inlays of brass, copper, and engraved pewter form a refined decoration of arabesques, foliage, and cartouches inspired by Louis XIV, executed with great finesse. Its flowing shape with softened corners, resting on small turned feet, gives it a particularly elegant silhouette. All sides are richly adorned with marquetry, reflecting the high-quality craftsmanship of a Parisian cabinetmaker. The interior is fully lined with beautiful purple velvet, offering ample storage space for jewelry, valuable
