It features a richly architected front with large molded panels embellished with carved recesses and remarkable star-shaped inlaid medallions, crafted from various types of wood. The decoration is enhanced by numerous carved and partially gilded ornaments--including shells, scrollwork, and foliage--culminating in an imposing central cartouche above the doors. The rounded posts, the overhanging cornice, and the spindle legs lend the piece remarkable elegance and presence. The interior retains its original chest lock and hardware. The piece retains a beautiful, warm, and authentic patina. A few cracks and
