A prestige weapon with a blade most likely salvaged from a European billhook. Cast bronze hilt. The hilt's style suggests it was crafted by the Yoruba people (Nigeria, Benin, Togo). There is a small crack at the bottom of the bronze, which does not affect the overall strength of the piece. General oxidation of the steel.
