Description

A rare and elegant Art Deco-style perfume bottle, featuring a refined combination of molded crystal, a filigree brass frame, and a remarkable sculpted stopper. The bottle's body, crafted from bohemian crystal tinted a delicate aqua green, features a geometric cut characteristic of the 1925-1935 period. It is adorned with a sumptuous openwork metal setting, set with turquoise cabochons that lend it a precious quality and an Orientalist charm that was very much in vogue during that period. The true highlight of this piece lies in its spectacular, finely carved frosted crystal stopper. It depicts a couple, likely in the midst of a marriage proposal, with two doves facing each other below. The scene is set beneath a garland of roses, a timeless symbol of love, fidelity and peace. The quality of the carving, with its smooth
